Biomedical Presentation

Rheumatoid arthritis, gout, bursitis.

Clinical Presentation

Muscle aches, joint pain, radiating pain in the leg, numbness of lower extremities, pain in trunk or lower extremities.

Tongue

White, possibly with a slimy tongue coat.

Pulse

Slippery, possibly choppy pulse.

Energetic Functions

Quickens the blood and transforms stasis, dispels wind dampness, relieves pain.

Chinese Medical Indications

Wind-damp impediment.

Blood stasis.

Dong Quai, Red Peony root, Ligusticum (*chuan xiong*) root, and Prepared Rehmannia is a variation of *Si Wu Tang* (Four-Substance Decoction) that quickens the blood and transforms stasis. The quickening action is assisted by Persica seed. Poria, Red Atractylodes, Citrus peel, Notopterygium, Fragrant Angelica (*bai zhi*) root, Chinese Clematis, Stephania, and Gentian (*qin jiao*) root dispel wind-damp impediment, especially below the waist. Achyranthes guides the formula to the lower extremities and quickens the blood.

Formula Differentiation

Clematis & Stephania Formula is indicated for pain in the muscles, joints and nerves, especially below the waist. This formula treats replete patterns.

Simultaneous blood vacuity and wind-damp impediment is better addressed by **Du Huo & Loranthus Formula** which is indicated for liver and kidney vacuity as well as qi and blood vacuity along with wind-damp impediment. This formula is also indicated for low back pain due to kidney vacuity.

Cautions and Contraindications

Contraindicated in cases of yin vacuity or during pregnancy.
